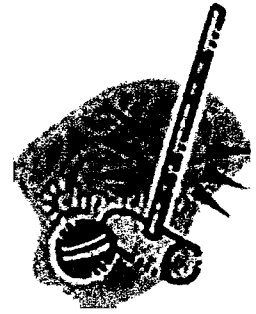


HOLDFAST BAY CROQUET CLUB
